Current Career Situation

The school's nearly six hundred students are 98% Hispanic, 85% English Language Learners, and 97% qualify for free/reduced lunch.

Prior to This

Prior to this I served as the principal at Garcia Elementary in Houston ISD where we transformed one of the city's lowest performing elementary schools into one recognized by the Texas Education Agency for academic performance in reading and top 25% in student growth. While in HISD I also served as the Dean of Students at Hamilton Middle School in the heart of the Heights. There I was responsible for the math department, sixth and seventh grade, facilities and maintenance, and led a three million dollar bond renovation. Prior to my leadership career I was a teacher and math content specialist in Fort Bend ISD.

Personal, Education, Family

My wife (Loren), our two boys (Ben and Sam), and our two dogs (Luna and Molly) and I live in the Spring Branch area and are parishioners at St. Michael's Catholic Church. We are diehard Texas Longhorn fans and love to spend Saturdays in the fall watching the game, enjoying the outdoors, and specializing in "one pot cooking." My father introduced me to the outdoors from an early age and I remain an avid fisherman and duck hunter.

As natives of the Houston area my family grew up as parishioners of St. Theresa's Catholic Church in Sugar Land, and my sisters and I all attended local Catholic grade schools and high schools. I am a proud graduate of St. Thomas High School. There I learned the values of goodness, discipline, and knowledge that helped shape me into the man I am today. My undergraduate degree is from The University of Texas at Austin, I earned my masters in educational administrations from The University of Houston, and I am currently back at The University of Texas pursuing my doctoral work where my research focuses on the competitive market place in education.
