Initially, I planned and executed all aspects of the move to a separate middle school campus including strategically planning for and accumulating over \$1,500,000 in gifts to commence the construction of the Charles Clayton Campus at Lake Highland Preparatory School.

Prior to This

Prior to becoming the Head of the Lake Highland Preparatory School Charles Clayton Campus and the Director of the Middle School, I served as Associate Director of the High School in which I planned, implemented, monitored, and assessed a classroom instructional program which

was consistent with Lake Highland Preparatory School's mission and strategic goals. I provided the administrative support to bring the 66,000 square ft. math and science building online. I emphasized the need to build meaningful relationships among students through the creation of advising and mentoring programs, student field-trip retreats, and team-work community service projects. Throughout my tenure at Lake Highland, I have instructed classes including; Advanced Placement Human Geography and 7th Grade World Cultures, and served the school as the Head Varsity Basketball Coach and the Lacrosse Administrator.

Before relocating to Orlando, I worked at Owego Free Academy, Elmira Notre Dame High School, Sayre High School, and Epiphany School. My work ranged from teaching High School Global Studies to Elementary Physical Education, along with serving as the Head Varsity Football, Basketball, and Tennis Coach, and as the Athletic Director.
