

<u>We The Future Contest</u> - offers a \$1000 scholarship for high school students and a mentoring trip. Entry topics are based on the U.S. Constitution. In order to apply students must attend a two or four-year college and be a US citizen.

**The Bright Futures Scholarship Fund** - provides additional scholarship opportunities to the many worthy applicants that seek funding each year. The selection committee looks for students showing academic excellence whose educational opportunities will be increased by financial assistance. In addition, the selection committee will take into consideration the overall quality of the personal statement. Special consideration will be given to working students and those pursuing a teaching or master's degree with an emphasis in the teaching of mathematics.

<u>The Edward M Nagel Scholarship</u> - is open to undergraduate students pursuing studies in business (and business related majors). Up to \$3000. Requires full time enrollment at an accredited 4-year college or university and demonstrated financial need.

In order to be eligible to apply to the National College Match in the fall of 2018, applicants must graduate from high school during or before the summer of 2019 and plan to enroll as a freshman in college in the fall of 2019. Finalists typically come from households earning less than \$65,000 annually for a family of four, and often less. This is not a strict cut-off and we encourage students who feel they have faced significant financial hardship to review these financial details carefully to see if they may qualify.

<u>Odenza Marketing Group Fall Scholarship</u> – is designed for students who are between the ages of 16 and 25 who have maintained a 2.5 GPA or greater in the most recent year completed. **Only one student per year may be honored as a school's DAR Good Citizen.** Each school's DAR Good Citizen receives a DAR Good Citizen pin, certificate and wallet recognition card. This student is eligible, if he/she wishes, to enter the DAR Good Citizens scholarship contest. The DAR Good Citizens scholarship contest consists of two parts. Part I consists of the student describing how he/she has tried to manifest the qualities of a good citizen. This part may be completed at home and is to be submitted together with a grade transcript and two letters of recommendation. Part II is a time essay.

# Deadline for Part I of the scholarship is due on October 12, 2018; applications are available in Ms. Rawls office in the counseling center.

<u>The Horatio Alger Texas Scholarship Program</u> - provides financial assistance to students in the State of Texas who have exhibited integrity and perseverance in overcoming personal adversity and who aspire to pursue higher education.
