Basilian Fathers Scholarship for Inner-City Catholic Schools

“Teach me Goodness, Discipline and Knowledge” is the motto of the Basilian Fathers and St. Thomas High School. Committed to this motto, the Basilian Fathers are interested in and committed to educating young men of all backgrounds, who can handle a college preparatory curriculum in a challenging, caring and supportive Catholic environment.

The Basilian Fathers at St. Thomas High School have a long history of helping financially needy students to make their dreams of going to St. Thomas a reality. To go one step further, we want to support Catholic education in the Arch-Diocese of Galveston-Houston as well as the effort of teachers and students in the schools that are officially designated as the Inner-City Catholic Schools.

Therefore, to encourage hard work, scholarship, and leadership, each year the Basilian Fathers will offer a scholarship to St. Thomas High School to one boy in each of the designated schools, who meets the criteria listed below.

- The award is \$7,500 per academic year.
- Winner chosen by Basilian Fathers Scholarship Committee based on nomination received from his current school, score on the HSPT (High School Placement Test) or ISEE (Independent School Entrance Exam), and his academic, disciplinary, and citizenship record in junior high.
- To maintain the scholarship each year the recipient must:
 1. Maintain a 2.00 average with no failing semester grade.
 2. Have a good conduct record.
 3. Have a good attendance record.
