Scholarships and Awards – October 2018

The Terry Foundation Scholarship - is awarded to Texas high school seniors who have been accepted for admission to one of the Terry-affiliated public universities in Texas. The Terry Scholarship is intended to provide scholarships up to the cost of attendance to outstanding students. Other scholarships or aid and family household contribution will be considered when determining the Terry scholarship stipend. In addition, you must complete the FAFSA application in order to be consider for the scholarship.**

The DAR Good Citizens program and scholarship contest- is intended to encourage and reward the qualities of good citizenship. The program is open to all senior class students enrolled in accredited public or private secondary schools that are in good standing with their state boards of education.

Only one student per year may be honored as a school's DAR Good Citizen. Each school's DAR Good Citizen receives a DAR Good Citizen pin, certificate and wallet recognition card. This student is eligible, if he/she wishes, to enter the DAR Good Citizens scholarship contest. The DAR Good Citizens scholarship contest consists of two parts. **Part I** consists of the student describing how he/she has tried to manifest the qualities of a good citizen. This part may be completed at home and is to be submitted together with a **grade transcript** and **two letters of recommendation**. Part II is a time essay.

Applications are available in Ms. Rawls office 2220 and the Deadline for Part I of the scholarship is due on October 12, 2018.

Wendy's High School Heisman Scholarship – is your chance to earn a scholarship toward college, as well as local, state, and national recognition for all that you've put into your high school career. If you've maintained at least a B average, participate in at least one eligible sport, are a leader in your community and role model at your school, then you've got what it takes to be a Wendy's High School Heisman.

The Horatio Alger Texas Scholarship Program - provides financial assistance to students in the State of Texas who have exhibited integrity and perseverance in overcoming personal adversity and who aspire to pursue higher education.

The Coca-Cola Scholars Program Scholarship - is an achievement-based scholarship awarded to graduating high school seniors each year. Students are recognized for their capacity to lead and serve, and their commitment to making a significant impact on their schools and communities.

The Stokes Educational Scholarship Program - facilitates the recruitment of individuals (high school seniors majoring in computer science or computer/electrical engineering), particularly minority students, who have demonstrated skills critical to the National Security Agency (NSA). As a NSA employee with the Stokes Program, you will attend college full time, receive up to \$30,000 per year for tuition and mandatory fees and a year round salary. You will work at NSA for 12 weeks during the summer in areas related to your course of study. If selected as a Program participant, you are required to work for NSA in the area of study, following graduation for at least one-and-one-half times your length of study. Cost of tuition must be reimbursed to government if employment is terminated prior to fulfillment. See website for requirements and application or call 1-866-NSA-HIRE or 410-854-4725.

VFW Voice of Democracy Scholarship Program - is a national audio-essay scholarship competition for 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th graders. Participants record their essays on an announced patriotic theme. A state winner is selected for national competition. Each state winner receives an all-expense-paid trip to Washington, D.C., where he/she competes for national scholarships, the stop scholarship being 30,000. Contact your school principal, counselor, local VFW Post or visit our website at the beginning of the school year for detailed information. Entries must be submitted ONLY to your local VFW Post or your high school.
