Scholarships and Awards – November 2018

The Terry Foundation Scholarship - is awarded to Texas high school seniors who have been accepted for admission to one of the Terry-affiliated public universities in Texas. The Terry Scholarship is intended to provide scholarships up to the cost of attendance to outstanding students. Other scholarships or aid and family household contribution will be considered when determining the Terry scholarship stipend. Please contact each **individual school** for specific instructions. **Please view the deadlines below for each Terry-affiliated school. In addition, you must complete the FAFSA application in order to be consider for the scholarship.**

Emmanuel College Catholic High School Graduate Award – this award recognizes a student’s commitment to academics and service in high school and promotes their continued studies at Emmanuel. All graduates of a Catholic high school who are accepted to Emmanuel College will receive this award and no additional scholarship application is required. Early Action 1- November 1; Early Action 2 – December 15, Regular Admission February 15; FAFSA priority filing date – February 15.

University of Dayton’s Future Flyer Pitch competition - a startup-style competition gives future entrepreneurs the chance to earn up to \$40,000 in scholarships over four years to the University of Dayton. To enter the competition, students must submit a two-minute video that presents a solution to a challenge faced by their local community. The contest is open to teams of up to four juniors or seniors, but there is no limit on the number of teams that can participate.

Video submissions are due November 1, 2018; apply online at go.udayton.edu/future-flyer-pitch.

American Legion Oratorical Contest - awards annual scholarships for undergraduate studies available to eligible high school students under the age of 20, and residing in Texas. Four awards from \$500 - \$2,000. First place winner to enter state contest. State winner to compete in national contest. National finalists are awarded scholarships of \$14,000-\$18,000.

Basis for selection: Competition, talent, interest in oratory debate, breadth of knowledge, originality, application of knowledge of topic, skill in selecting examples and analogies, logic, voice, diction style language and delivery. Applicant must demonstrate patriotism.

The contest consists of two speeches: A Prepared Oration and an Assigned Topic. The Prepared Oration must be on some aspect of the Constitution of the United States with emphasis on the duties and obligations of a citizen to our government. The Assigned Topic will be selected from Articles and Sections as listed under Assigned Topics for the current year’s contest.

National Honor Society Scholarship –is available to high school seniors who are NHS members in good standing. Selection is based on outstanding scholarship, leadership, service and character. Prudential Spirit of Community Awards – In partnership with Prudential Financial, students in grades 5 – 12 are recognized for exemplary community service. State honorees each receive \$1,000, as well as an engraved silver medallion, plus an all-expenses-paid trip with one parent or guardian to Washington, D.C. for national recognition. In addition, National honorees (America’s Top Ten) will receive personal awards of \$5000, a gold medallion, a crystal trophy for their school or organization, and a \$5,000 grant from The Prudential Foundation for a non-profit, charitable organization of their choice.

Most Valuable Student Scholarship Award - The Elks National Foundation awards 500 competitive, four-year scholarships ranging from \$1,000/year to \$12,500/year. Applicants need not be related to a member of the Elks. Applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership and financial need. To be eligible the applicant must be pursuing a four-year degree, on a full-time basis at a U.S. college or university. The applicant must also be a high school senior who is a citizen of the United States on the date their application is signed; permanent legal resident status does not qualify.

National Co-Op Scholarship program – encourages students interested in science, mathematics, engineering and technology to apply for this merit co-op scholarship. To qualify for this scholarship, students must have a minimum 3.5 GPA, apply for the 2018-2019 academic year to one of the WACE Partner institutions, complete the National co-op scholarship application, and include a typed one-page essay (200 words) describing why you have chosen to pursue a college cooperative education program.

The Chinese Professional Club of Houston - is now accepting applications for its 2018 - 2019 scholarship competition. Scholarships will consider academic, community service and extra-curricular performance. All college-bound high school seniors of Chinese descent in the Houston metropolitan area are eligible and encouraged to apply.

Allied Van Lines - will award one scholarship in the amount of \$1000. Students must submit a 400-800-word essay, in a personalized informal tone, explaining why a career in logistics/supply chain management is their college major of choice.

Eligibility requirements: must be a U.S. citizen, receipt of most recent transcripts and submission of essay. Must also provide verification of full-time enrollment or acceptance to an accredited college or university within the U.S., into an undergraduate degree program in Logistics or equivalent field. Employees, families of employees, affiliates and agents of Allied Van Lines are not eligible to apply.

The U.S. Department of State - offers merit-based scholarships for American high school students to study abroad from three weeks to an academic year. Students live with host families, engage with local schools, and gain skills to be competitive in the global workforce. Previous language study is not required for most programs.

Assumption College Brassard Scholarship – awards a \$10,000 Scholarship to Catholic High School Students. As a Catholic high school student, you recognize and appreciate the value of a faith-based education, and if you are accepted for admission to Assumption you will be awarded the annual \$2,500 Br. Brassard Scholarship.

Assumption College Light the Way Scholarship - is awarded to incoming students who utilize their abilities to Light the Way for others. Whether it's community service to help people in need, innovation to improve society, or volunteering to heal our planet, this scholarship recognizes and supports students who positively impact the world in their own meaningful way. Each year, Assumption College will award up to **50, \$25,000 scholarships**, renewable all four years.

GE-Reagan Foundation Scholarship – awards a scholarship to high school seniors who demonstrate exceptional leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship. This program annually provides college-bound students with \$10,000 renewable scholarships – up to \$40,000 total per recipient – and supports them as they lead and serve in college and beyond.

The APIASF General Scholarship - is open to Asian American and Pacific Islander high school and college students who will be enrolling or are currently enrolled in a U.S. accredited college or university as a degree-seeking undergraduate student in the upcoming academic year. There are multiple scholarship opportunities that vary in award amount, number of years, field of study, location, and more. **Application Opens: Thursday, September 14, 2017.**

Seton Hall University Scholarships - you must apply to Seton Hall University. However, you may apply for the scholarship prior to notification of admission. The criteria listed below determines eligibility only and does not guarantee receipt of the scholarship.

The **Catholic High School Achievement Award** is a competitive scholarship awarded exclusively to incoming freshmen currently enrolled in a Catholic high school who have a minimum of an unweighted 3.0 GPA and a 1350 SAT (new) 1290 SAT two-score (old) or 29 on the ACT as well as a strong record of involvement in your high school, community or church.

This \$2,000 award is renewable for three additional years for a total award of \$8,000 as long as the student maintains a 3.0 GPA and earns at least 30 credits annually. There is no application required for this scholarship; the scholarship is automatically awarded to students who meet the eligibility requirements shortly after admission.

Washington Crossing Foundation Scholarship - awards \$500 to \$5,000 for students planning careers in government service, for study at the college of the recipient's choice. All awards are for one year.

Applications will be accepted only at P. O. Box 503, Levittown, PA 19058-0503 as indicated in the instructions. Please note that scholarship applications are to be POSTMARKED by January 15, 2019. Apply online at www.gwcf.org.

Coolidge Scholarship - is a full-ride, four-year, merit scholarship that may be used by recipients for undergraduate study at any accredited college or university in the United States. Any high school junior who plans on enrolling in college in the fall of 2020 and is an American citizen or legal permanent resident is eligible to apply (unfortunately current high school seniors are not eligible to apply). Coolidge Scholars are selected based primarily on academic excellence. Secondary criteria include: an interest in public policy, an appreciation for and understanding of the values President Coolidge championed, as well as humility and service.

Deadline to apply is January 23, 2019; apply online at www.coolidgescholars.org.

Texas Student Housing – this scholarship is open to students accepted to colleges in Austin, College Station, or Denton, Texas that have not signed off-campus housing leases.

Applications are available in Ms. Rawls office 2220 and the application deadline is January 31, 2019.

The Carr P. Collins Scholars Program - was established to recognize and reward students who have demonstrated leadership through service.

Application requirements:

1. Completed scholarship application (below)
2. Resume of your high school honors, awards, achievements, extracurricular activities and community service
3. **Handwritten** essay of no more than 500 words illustrating your concept of leadership and how your community service experiences have impacted your life
4. Nomination for the Carr P. Collins Scholars Program from a teacher, counselor or principal that includes a brief explanation of why you deserve the scholarship

Lawrence Technological University’s Scholarship Competition – apply to Lawrence Tech for the Fall 2019 semester at www.ltu.edu/apply. Write a 500-word response to the following topic and submit your essay online at www.ltu.edu/scholarshipcompetition by February 1, 2019. Please include your name, phone number, and intended major on your essay.

INNOVATION is a hallmark of a Lawrence Technological University education. Choose a person whose innovations have inspired you. Explain why that person was successful and how his or her innovation is helpful to society. What characteristics of the innovator would you like to incorporate into your own life?

Diversity Scholars Program - can be used to cover educational related expenses including tuition, fees and housing. Each student will receive \$5,000 per year for a maximum of eight semesters of study. In this scholarship program students receive more than just a financial award. Diversity Scholars also receive academic support from program staff to assist them in successfully transitioning to UT Dallas through academic check-ins, workshops and various leadership & conference opportunities.

We the students Essay Contest - the Bill of Rights Institute will conduct an essay contest in focusing on the principles of the Constitution and their relevance today. To enter, eligible students must log on to the essay website and submit an entry that follows the Submission Guidelines as detailed in Section III. The Bill of Rights Institution is asking students to personalize their essays while encouraging them to expand their understanding of citizenship beyond an abstract concept, envisioning it as knowledge and actions inspired by America’s founding principles. The specific essay prompt this year is: “What are essential qualities of a citizen in your community in 21st century America?”

The Texas Italian –American Sports Foundation Scholarship – awards scholarships to deserving college student athletes, who participate in a school-sanctioned sport, makes passing grades, and have a financial need. Students are eligible for four years, providing they continue to meet the scholarship criteria.
