READ THROUGH THE SUMMARY OF EACH SCHOLARSHIP OFFERED TO DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY.

We The Future Contest - offers a \$1000 scholarship for high school students and a mentoring trip. Entry topics are based on the U.S. Constitution. In order to apply students must attend a two or four-year college and be a US citizen.

The Bright Futures Scholarship Fund - provides additional scholarship opportunities to the many worthy applicants that seek funding each year. The selection committee looks for students showing academic excellence whose educational opportunities will be increased by financial assistance. In addition, the selection committee will take into consideration the overall quality of the personal statement. Special consideration will be given to working students and those pursuing a teaching or master's degree with an emphasis in the teaching of mathematics.

The Edward M Nagel Scholarship - is open to undergraduate students pursuing studies in business (and business related majors). Up to \$3000. Requires full time enrollment at an accredited 4-year college or university and demonstrated financial need.

The 2019 National College Match - is looking for high school seniors who have shown outstanding academic ability despite financial challenges. In order to be eligible to apply to the National College Match in the fall of 2019, applicants must graduate from high school during or before the summer of 2020 and plan to enroll as a freshman in college in the fall of 2020. Finalists typically come from **households earning less than \$65,000 annually for a family of four**, and often less. This is not a strict cut-off and we encourage students who feel they have faced significant financial hardship to review these financial details carefully to see if they may qualify.

Odenza Marketing Group Fall Scholarship – is designed for students who are between the ages of 16 and 25 who have maintained a 2.5 GPA or greater in the most recent year completed. Don't Text and Drive Scholarship - is to help you understand the risks of texting while driving. You must currently be enrolled in high school and also a U.S. citizen or legal resident. Complete the online application and include a 140-character message about texting while driving. The top 10 applications will be selected as finalists. The finalists will be asked to write a full length 500- to 1,000-word essay about texting while driving.

Voice of Democracy - has been the Veterans of Foreign Wars' premier scholarship program. Each year, nearly 40,000 high school students compete for more than \$2 million in scholarships and incentives. Students compete by writing and recording an audio essay on an annual patriotic theme. This year's theme is, What Makes America Great.

Deadline to apply is October 31, 2019; applications are available in Ms. Rawls office 2221A.

Boston University Financial assistance program - will meet 100% full need of any admitted first-year student. Students' financial need will be determined based on the FAFSA and CSS Profile. Once BU determined what a family's expected contribution is, they subtract that from the full cost of attendance. The difference—calculated need—will be made up by financial aid.
