

Eagle Hybrid Learning


We will follow a Block Schedule, which means your son's eight classes will be held over the course of two days. On Block A days (First Day), periods A-D meet and on Block B days (Second Day), periods E-H meet.

The students have been divided into two groups, Aquinas and Basil. When the Aquinas group is at school, the Basil group will be in remote learning and when the Basil group is in school, the Aquinas group will be in remote learning.

What will Eagle Hybrid Learning look like for your son?

- He will have direct interaction with the teacher in each class for that day, either in-person or remote.
- The instruction may be synchronous, which means the teacher will be teaching both the remote and in-person group at the same time or asynchronous, which means the teacher will have the remote group working independently while instructing the in-person group and then will have the in-person group begin independent work while instructing the remote group.
- He will have clear daily objectives and due dates/times for his assignments. All this information can be found in the Learning Activity Packet (LAP), which is on the Portal "Topics" Tab. The LAP provides the student with the daily work and activities for a unit of study. On the LAP the student will find the objectives for the unit of study, the activities for each day, the homework assignments, and the dates of assessments. The instruction for the Aquinas and Basil group will be clear on the LAP.
- Attendance will be taken every day. Students must be present for all required activities during the class period, both in-person and remotely.
- He will be expected to be in dress code each day (in-person or remote) and have the camera turned on and facing him during remote instruction.
- He will be expected to wear a mask at all times when on campus.

- He should bring a water bottle with him as all water fountains have been shut off.
- He will be expected to adhere to the St. Thomas Handbook in its totality, including the policies as they relate to technology. The complete student handbook can be found here: <https://www.sths.org/campus-life/student-life/>
- There will be time between classes to allow for transition to the next class and a period of time for lunch. The schedule for each day will be:

Students in Remote Learning have lunch and preparation time from 10:53 a.m. - 12:14 p.m.

Students who are on campus will have either Lunch 1 or Lunch 2. This will be assigned based on their B/F period. Please note: the students' lunch assignments will be available September 8 in the student portal.

Lunch/Study Hall will look like this:

- **Lunch 1** – will go to lunch from 10:53am – 11:23am then return to B/F for Study hall from 11:28am -12:14pm.
- **Lunch 2** – will remain in B/F for study hall from 10:53am-11:39am, with lunch from 11:44pm. – 12:14pm.
