One of the humblest and most loyal servants in their vocation to St. Thomas High School was Father Donald Cooper, '40, C.S.B. After becoming an ordained priest in 1950, Father Cooper's service at St. Thomas would continue for the next 30

years, including a period as principal from 1968 - 1976. Father Cooper not only had a strong desire to build St. Thomas' prominence with an academically strong and faithful student body, but a will to make each graduate from here the epitome of "Goodness, Discipline, and Knowledge." This extraordinary commitment to his alma mater would earn Father Cooper the nickname, "Mr. St. Thomas."
