


QuickScreen COVID-19 Student Screening Tool

All students are required to self-screen on all school days for COVID-19 symptoms as a precautionary measure to reduce the spread of COVID-19 within the campus community. *Students must do the screening in the morning before the school day begins.*

We ask every parent/guardian to make sure their student does the self-screening **before leaving home** and coming to campus through the QuickScreen tool. <u>This screening should also be on school days if the</u> <u>student is home ill.</u> <u>Click here</u> for the link to the QuickScreen for students.

- The screening takes less than a minute
- Make sure to put the student's first and last name (not the parent's) and the student's school ID number. You will find the ID in your STH portal. It must be the student's correct ID number for the system to properly compile the needed data. Click "remember "me for the system to remember this information each time for log in.
- After answering the brief questionnaire, a green or red screen with instructions for how to proceed
- The student's answers to the self-assessment questions will be documented and confidentially maintained



GREEN screening result - the student is cleared to come to campus as usual

RED screening result – the student should stay home until parent/guardian has spoken with the Dean of Students Office to clear or not clear the student to come to campus *No student should come to campus with a red screening until cleared by the Dean's Office.* After communicating

with the Dean's Office the parent should monitor the student's symptoms and call a doctor if symptoms continue.
